Camp Dress Standard at WWBC

We have the right to ask any camper to change clothes if they do not comply with our dress standard. These are the standards that we have adopted for our week together, and we ask for you to cooperate with an attitude pleasing to the Lord.

Clothing must not display or promote ungodly living such as alcohol, drugs, tobacco, or vulgarity. Clothing must be appropriate for a variety of camp activities, such as running, climbing, or wearing a harness.

Modest <u>shirts</u> are required: if the sleeves have been removed, the body of the shirt must remain intact. No tank tops, spaghetti straps, low-cut or tight-fitting shirts are allowed. Undergarments must not be visible.

The same standards apply for <u>dresses</u>. All dresses and skirts must be at least knee length.

All <u>Shorts</u> must reach at least the middle of the thigh even while seated. Shorts may not be excessively baggy or tight fitting. Tight fitting <u>pants</u> (or leggings) may only be worn under shorts, skirts, or dresses.

During water activities, mid-thigh shorts and shirts that cannot be seen through are required.

<u>Shoes</u> are required when you are outdoors (except during waterslide and volleyball). Flip-flops are not acceptable footwear for the river. Some activities require sturdier "closed toe" shoes.

In the event an outfit is questionable, a camper may be asked to change. We encourage your cooperation as we "consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds (Heb 10:24)".
